

SUMMARY OF **DP2** INFORMATION EVENING

20 SEPTEMBER 2017

- Mentor and Tutorial Programme
- Assessment:
 - One progress check (October) where necessary, two written reports (Decembers, April)
 - Mock Exams after Feb. Break: Thu. 8 - Wed. 14 March
 - All Internal Assessment is externally moderated by IB Examiners
- After each report: appointment evenings Thu. 14 Dec. and Wed. 11 April, to discuss progress with individual teachers and mentor
- Final IBDP Examinations in May: Mon. 30 Apr. – Fri. 18 May 2018 (please note that exams start in 2nd week of the May break)
- Final grades: 70-75% written examination, 25-30% internal assessment; exam results published on 5 July
- Most important general requirements to pass the final IBDP exams: min. 24 points; min. 12 points for HL required, 9 points for SL. Maximum number of points is 45 (6x7 + 3 extra points in ToK and the Extended Essay). For further detail about Diploma requirements, please see Ms. Jansma.
- Possible extra points for Extended Essay and ToK; max. 3, e.g. when an A is scored both on the Extended Essay and ToK 3 extra points are awarded - “grades” given: A - E, E being a failing grade for the diploma
- CAS, ToK and Extended Essay are failing conditions; grade D or higher in ToK and Extended Essay required, CAS needs to be completed and approved before deadline
- Resits in November (only for students who failed the Diploma) or following May;
- Early results service for universities; student needs to give IBO permission to send results directly to university – students will be informed by Ms. Jansma
- Extended Essay deadline: Mon. 30 Oct. (after autumn break); complete and **final** version
- Catch up Tests restricted (see Diploma Programme Guide)
- Deadlines are vital (see Diploma Programme Guide)
- Attendance: Lateness and absence (see Diploma Programme Guide)
